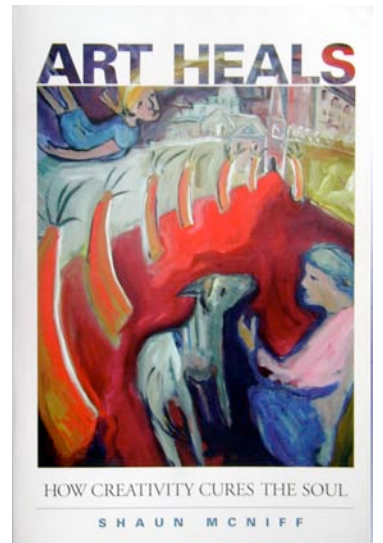

Shaun McNiff is an internationally recognized authority on the arts and healing, creativity enhancement, creativity and leadership, and art-based research, which was first formulated by his writings. He is an exhibiting painter and author of many books that include *Art Heals: How Creativity Cures the Soul*, *Trust the Process: An Artist's Guide to Letting Go*; *Art as Medicine: Creating a Therapy of the Imagination*; *Creating with Others: The Practice of Imagination in Life, Art and the Workplace*; *Art-Based Research*, *Depth Psychology of Art*, and *The Arts and Psychotherapy*. His most recent book, *Integrating the Arts in Therapy. History, Theory, and Practice*, was published in 2009 and his writings have been translated into Chinese, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, Portuguese, Russian, German, and other languages.

McNiff has received various honors and awards for his work including the Honorary Life Member Award of the American Art Therapy Association. He established the first expressive arts therapy graduate training program at Lesley University from which the discipline of expressive arts therapy emerged and in 2002 Lesley University appointed him as its first University Professor.
